R.E. Dropping off/Picking up of Children

There has been a number of occurrences over recent months when arrangements for dropping off and picking up children from swimming sessions has given cause for concern. In particular there has been a number of occasions where children have been left unsupervised before and after training sessions, sometimes for long periods of time. Until a coach/helper is on the premises for the training session your child is still your responsibility.

The safety of the children is paramount to the club and it is essential that there is a robust and structured procedure with regards to dropping off and picking up of children from their training sessions.

Therefore to avoid any children within the club being put at unnecessary risk we ask that all parents/guardians adhere to the following:

1. No child must be left at the beginning of a training session without a parent/guardian until a coach/helper has arrived.
2. At the end of a session, children must be picked up at the correct time promptly from within the premises.

This will ensure that your child is always correctly supervised and that the club is in turn adhering to its duty of care for your child.

This is a matter which the club takes very seriously and therefore with this in mind we ask that all parents/guardians adhere to the above with immediate effect. Compliance with this will be part of the conditions of your child participating within the club.
